Important Information about Residential Waste Collection

Hunt Management has awarded a three-year Contract to Waste Management to service the once per week curbside collection of residential trash, yard waste and recyclables from single family residences.

Traditional Service: Curbside Collection

Traditional Service includes: once per week collection of household trash, bulky waste and yard waste, as well as every-other-week collection of single-stream recyclables. Place your items at the curb no earlier than 4:00 pm on the day before scheduled collection and remove carts and cans from the curb no later than 9:00 am the day following collection.

Waste Management observes the following six (6) holidays per year:

New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

If the holiday falls during the business week and it is before your pickup day, your pickup schedule will fall **"ONE DAY"** later for that week. If the holiday falls after your pickup day or on a Saturday or Sunday, your pickup schedule **"DOES NOT"** change.



Traditional Services Description

Trash Collection

One 96 gallon trash cart will be collected from your front curblines in the Waste Management provided mobile cart(s).

Recycling Collection

Recyclables are collected at your front curb line and will be serviced **EVERY OTHER WEEK**. A 96-gallon mobile cart is furnished to each residence for the storage and collection of single stream recyclables. The materials guide on the next page details the type of acceptable recyclables. There is no additional charge for additional mobile carts for recycling collection.

No hazardous materials such as oil, pesticides, insecticides, paint or batteries will be accepted.

Single Stream Recycling Guide

Instructions

- Commingle all acceptable recyclables in this cart (no sorting necessary)
- Please place your recycling cart at the curb
- Rinse food residue from containers
- All recyclables must be placed in the cart with the lid completely closed
- Do not bag the recyclables
- If in doubt, throw it in your trash. Non-recyclables can ruin the whole load



Paper

- Newspapers and inserts
- Cardboard (flatten all boxes) (no waxed cardboard)
- Mail, junk mail and envelopes
- Telephone books
- Molded cardboard/paper egg cartons
- Frozen food packaging
- Kraft brown bags
- Chipboard, such as cereal, cake and food mix boxes, gift boxes
- Magazines
- Paperback books (no hard covers)
- Carrier stock, such as soda and beer can carrying cases.
- Office and computer paper, notebooks and gift wrap (no metal clips, spirals, binders)
- Aseptic packaging such as juice cartons and pouches (remove straws)

Do not include:

- No food contaminated paper
- No pet soiled paper
- No napkins, tissue or toilet paper



Plastic

- PET soda, water and flavored beverage bottles
- HDPE Milk and juice jugs (clear), detergent and fabric softener containers (colored)
- PVC Narrow neck containers only, such as health and beauty aid products and household cleaners
- LDPE Grocery containers, such as margarine tubs, frozen dessert cups, six and twelve pack rings
- PP Grocery containers, such as yogurt cups and narrow neck syrup and ketchup bottles
- PS Plastic cutlery, CD cases, plastic cups
- Plastic narrow neck containers only
- Plastic buckets, such as kitty litter buckets (5 gallon maximum size)

Do not include:

- No plastic bags
- No Styrofoam
- No packing "peanuts"
- No plastic film or wrap
- No plastic newspaper sleeves



Cans & Foil

- Aluminum cans and foil (trays & foil must be cleaned)
- Tin and steel cans
- Non-hazardous aerosol cans, such as whipped cream or cooking oil (empty only)
- Lids from jars

Glass

- Glass bottles and jars (clear and colored)
- Food containers
- Beverage containers

Do not include:

- No window glass or mirrors
- No ceramics and dinnerware
- No light bulbs

Yard Waste Collection

Mobile cart will be collected curbside each week on Wednesday's. For collection, yard waste should be placed in your provided yard waste cart. Tree limbs and similar pruning that are tied using natural fiber twine should be no longer than four (4) feet, no greater than 4 inches in diameter and no heavier than 60 pounds.. Christmas trees are collected at the curb in December & January on the regularly scheduled collection day. All other months, yard waste restrictions will apply.

Bulky Trash Collection

All household furnishings such as mattresses, sofas, chairs and other large items that can be easily and safely handled by one person. For a complete list of acceptable materials, please see the attached list.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE PLACED AT THE CURB BY 6:00 AM ON YOUR SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY
